

Stream Conservation and Water Sanitation Mini-workshop

Date and time: December 20, 12:00-15:00 (Lunch will be provided)

Location: College of Social Science SS 108

Description of mini-workshop:

During the past years the Don-Da Creek neighboring the campus of Tunghai University had been severely polluted. Recently, Taichung City Government collaborated with Tunghai University to restore this creek back to a suitable natural habitat for wild plants and animals. In this mini-workshop, the students will visit Don-Da Creek water purification facilities, Da-Sher irrigation channel and Education Center and the guided tour and exhibits will help them realize stream biota, water sanitation theories/facilities and sustainable management of streams.

13:00-13:30: Guide tour to Dong-Da Creek water purification facility

13:30-14:00: Guide tour to Da-Sher irrigation channel and hydroelectric power system

14:00-14:20: Move to Dong-Da Creek Education Center

14:20-15:00: Guided tour on exhibits in the Education Center

1. Students completing the mini-workshop will have opportunity to serve as teaching assistants to lead Dong-Da Creek guided tour in English to international students taking Student Labor Program. Scholarship will be offered.
2. Those students interested in being the TA of Dong-Da Creek guided tour need to attend and pass the evaluation organized by Office of Student Labor Program to make sure that he or she is capable of performing the task.
